2. GIVE LECTURES ON CYCLE SAFETY ON COLLEGE CAMPUSES AT THE BEGINNING OF TERM AND AT ORIENTATION WEEK.
3. INCLUSION OF BICYCLE SAFETY INFORMATION AND HAZARDS AS THEY APPLY TO THE DRIVER, IN ALL AUTO DRIVING LEARNER EDUCATION COURSES AND TESTS. IN ALL CITY SCHOOLS AND PRIVATE DRIVING SCHOOL PROGRAMS.
4. BASIC BICYCLING RULES, PUBLISHED AS A SINGLE SHEET DOCUMENT, TO BE AVAILABLE AT SCHOOLS, CAMPUSES, BICYCLE STORES AND INCLUDED IN THE CITY PARKING PERMIT KITS.
5. A CITY ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE USE OF AND WEARING A SAFETY HELMET WHEN CYCLING.
6. PRESENT PROGRAMS ON BICYCLE SAFETY AND RULES, OFTEN ON THIS CITY'S LOCAL ACCESS TV CHANNELS.
7. ISSUANCE OF WARNINGS/ CITATIONS TO RIDERS WHO VIOLATE THE BICYCLE RULES.
